Reception and Key Stage 1

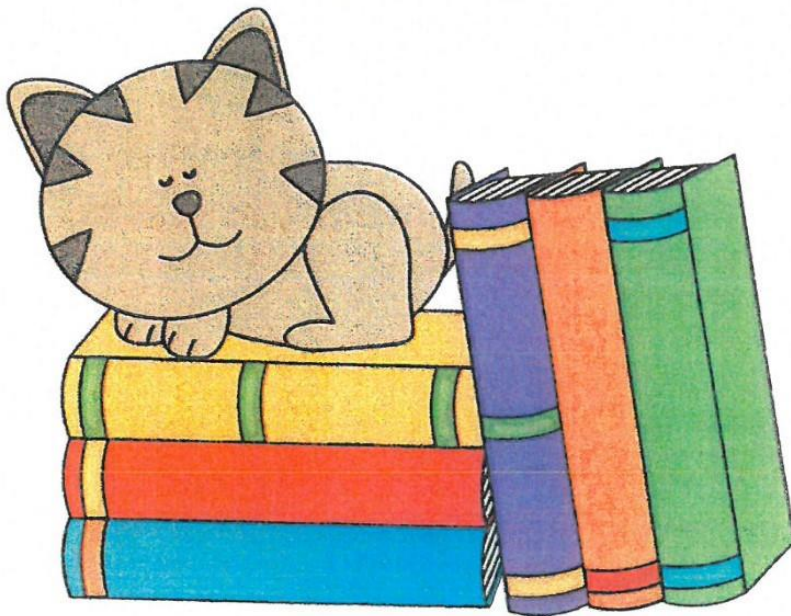
Dear Parents
