Spellings and homework are given out on a Friday afternoon (except in assessment weeks) in a homework folder. The written homework will be related to English, Maths or Topic. This needs to be completed and handed in by the following Tuesday.

Our spelling test will be on a Wednesday afternoon, please practise these with your child.

PE is on Tuesday afternoon, could you please make sure your child has the correct PE kit of black/blue shorts and white t shirt. Your child can leave their PE kit in school and it will be sent home at the end of each half term. Children are allowed to have a roll on deodorant to use after P.E if they wish.

Children need to have their book bags in school every day with their reading books and records so they can be checked and changed. Children need to read at least 5 times a week to move up the class reading wall and make good progress.
