Shirt	Blue, red or yellow polo
Sweater / Cardigan	Royal Blue
Trousers	Grey or black
Skirts	Grey (or pinafore)
Socks	Grey or white
Shoes	Black sensible type (plain black trainers are acceptable with no visible logo)
PE	Navy or black shorts House T-shirt (with or without new logo, available from Natasha's) Red – St. Teresa Green – St. Damien Blue – St. Vincent Orange – St. Josephine School hoodie (available from Natasha's) Plimsolls for indoor use Trainers for outdoor use
Outerwear	A sensible coat or raincoat

In summer girls may wear a blue checked dress. In winter girls may wear warm black or grey tights.

We do ask parents to help their children take pride in their appearance. Long hair should be tied back. No jewellery is allowed except for a watch or small stud earrings.

New to our uniform are school hoodies which are available from Natasha's but are strictly for P.E and coming to and from school. You may have your child's first name or surname printed on the back but no nicknames.

All children need a pump bag to keep their pumps and PE kit in. All items of clothing should be clearly labelled with the child's name. Sadly, school cannot accept any responsibility for items of clothing or personal property that go missing.
